This school year is winding down. It is hard to believe that in 25 days the 2016-2017 school year will be ending.

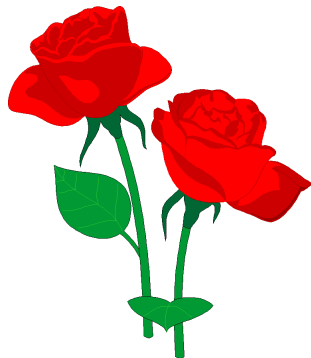

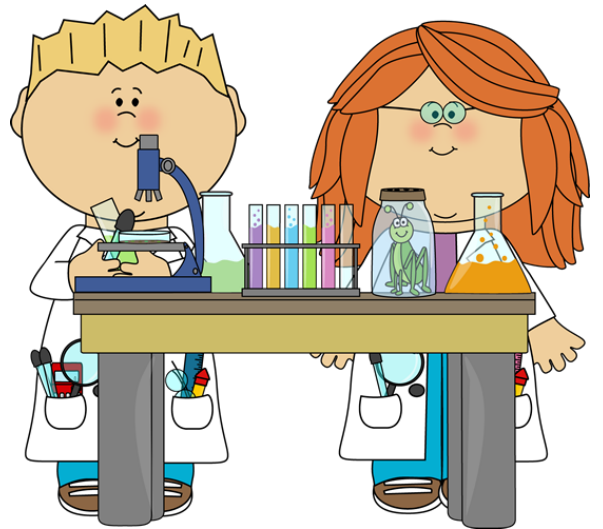
